New/Renewal Indicator added to Bordereau reporting (ref. 15865)

The New/Renewal indicator has been added to the list of available fields for bordereau reporting.

Policy Sub Section CSV output (ref. 15986)

The POLICYSUBSECTIONPROPERTY CSV file has been enhanced such that records are output even if a property contains a zero Sum Insured / Declared Value amount.

Add Section Text from risk to Underwriter Payments report (ref. 16013)

The Underwriter Payments report has been enhanced with an additional column containing the Section Text description from the associated risk section.

Thousand separator on amounts on instalment LPAN (ref. 16049)

For LPAN documents created per instalment, the Gross and Net amounts
